PRIMARY 1 GALLON GRADES

When the amount available allows, please order in increments of 3 plants - orders of less than three are subject to a 20% upcharge

NOTE - 1 gallons that are priced \$25.00 or more will be exempt.

1 Gal - L.S. - late shift - suitable in height for pot size but not fully rooted at the time of listing, caliper, branching and overall body will be somewhat diminished as compared to standard 1 gallon

1 Gal - F.S. - fresh shift - not rooted at the time of listing, all originating from a small cell or tube tray container

1 Gal - Liner - equal in height, body and caliper to a single season plant grown in a tube tray or graft pot

1 Gal - Usz - usually under 6" tall and sometimes down to just a few inches

1 Gal - 6" - usually 6-10" or 6-12" tall

1 Gal - Hvy Liner - not fully formed but far enough along that once flushed out in the spring it will approach a standard 1 gallon size plant

1 Gal - usually 10-24" tall and in most cases staked

1 Gal - 2 Yr - propagated from the previous season and have been in the same pot for 2 growing seasons

1 Gal - 2' - usually 27-36" tall and in most cases staked

1 Gal - 3' - usually 39-48" tall and in most cases staked

1 Gal - 4' - usually 53-60" tall and in most cases staked (there are a handful of cases where we will also list 5', 6' and 7' height)

EXCEPTIONS

The designation "1 Gal" for some dwarf upright plants will be a minimum of 8-12" in height unless otherwise indicated

Some shrubs, groundcovers and spreading plants will be graded on body with no height criteria

We reserve the right to change sizes up or down at any time prior to shipping - Usz and 6" plants will not be substituted without prior approval. If size changes are unacceptable please let us know when placing your initial order. If you require an exact size & amount before placing your order please indicate that preference, we will attempt to lock in your request upon final count

Price increases between heights (except very rare or very dwarf plants) will range from \$.75 to \$1.50, in rare cases \$2.50.

Prompt Pay Volume Discount - calculated at the time of invoice & only attributable when paid within terms. Pre-Pay Discount - 3/4% per month for every full month between the date of prepayment and the shipment date will be credited to the invoice as of the shipment date. Pre-Pay Discount is in addition to the Prompt Pay Volume Discount.
